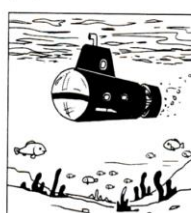

The Passing of a Legend

The sailing world has lost one of its greatest sailors. On Saturday, November 11th, Sandrine Pascal passed away peacefully in her sleep at the age of 87.

She had said in many past interviews that she knew it was for her because she felt as if she were flying. She also credited her father with teaching her everything that she knew about sailing. One year after her first trip out to sea, Ms. Pascal was sailing on her own. During her college years, she was the captain of the school's team three years in a row. 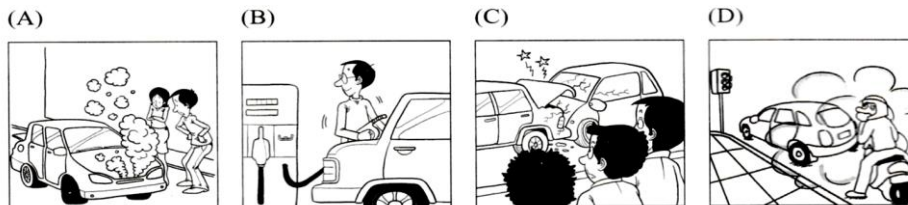
