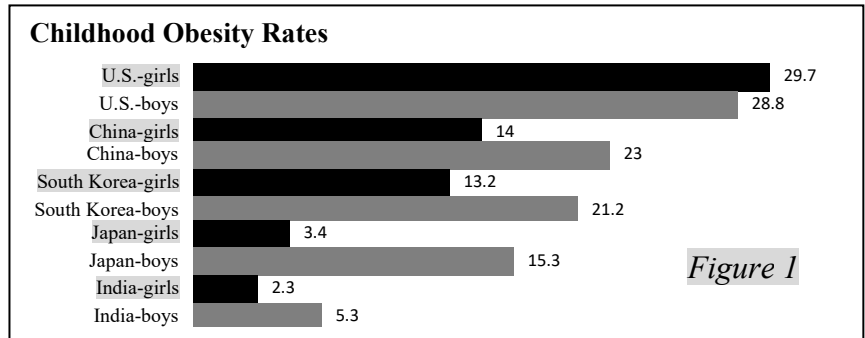

According to a study in a well-known medical journal, 28% of Chinese men and 27% of Chinese women are overweight or obese. The study defined the former as having a BMI of 25 or more, and the other as 30 or greater.

However, that's not the worst of it. China's future is also in trouble because its children are slowing themselves down with lots of extra weight. The study found that 23% of Chinese boys under 20 years old are overweight or obese, while 14% of Chinese girls have the same problem (see *Figure 1*). This can prove to be



deadly for the country because many doctors believe these super heavy children may not be able to see their parents die of old age. The biggest reason for this is that the obese kids will have to face many health problems. The biggest one is the risk of diabetes, and the others like cancer and heart disease. It goes without saying that unhealthy diets and a lack of exercise help the country's weight problem get bigger and bigger.
