Quiet Hour in Australian Supermarkets

Australian supermarket chain Coles introduced a Quiet Hour program last year. It is happening in 70 stores across the country. Quiet Hour takes place every Tuesday morning from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. During this time, the stores' lights are **dimmed** and the music is turned off. No announcements are made except for emergencies.

This is meant to create a comfortable setting for people with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). People with ASD often have difficulty in crowded, loud, or brightly lit environments. Coles worked with Autism Spectrum Australia to create this program. So far, the program has received positive responses from parents of children with ASD.

The supermarket chain plans to expand Quiet Hour to 103 more stores across Australia. By doing this, Coles intends to provide a more welcoming shopping experience for all their customers.

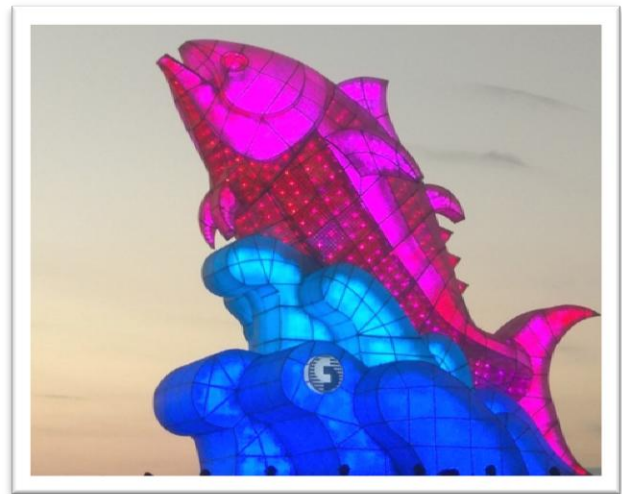
