These days, everyone has a smartphone. We take them everywhere, even to school or to work. But if you spend too much time looking at your phone at work, your boss might get angry. So, keep these rules in mind to get the most out of your workday.

- 1. If you want to make sure you don't spend too much time on your phone, what you should do is put your phone away. Put it in a desk drawer during work hours. If someone calls you with an emergency, you can still hear it and take it out. Otherwise, leave it there.
- 2. Use your smartphone for important calls only during business hours. Don't call up a friend just to chat. You can make personal calls during your break time, of course. Otherwise, save those for after hours.
- 3. Don't make personal calls in the office. Don't bother others who work in the same office with your conversation. Go outside, or at least into the hallway. But what you should never ever do is take your phone into the restroom to make a call. Respect other workers' privacy there.

In a word, you don't have to leave your smartphone at home. But when you're at work, you should respect your boss and other workers that you work with when you need to use your smartphone.

Does a person who gets very sick have the right to decide how and when to end his life? In most countries, euthanasia is not legal. Some people believe that our life is given by God, and only God can decide when it should end. Others worry that people who don't really want to die might be killed if euthanasia is made legal. Still others think that life is important, and that no matter how sick one is, there is always hope to get better if he keeps living. In fact, most doctors do not want to kill their patients because their job is to save lives.

Although many countries say no to euthanasia, more and more people think that it is a way to respect life. Take David Goodall for example. In 2018, the 104-year-old Australian flew to Switzerland, where euthanasia is legal, to end his own life. He said that he didn't enjoy his life anymore. He was happy that he could say goodbye to his family and friends before he died.

Euthanasia is controversial. A study taken in the United States shows that about 46% of Americans agree that euthanasia should be made legal, and 41% of Americans don't agree with it.
