



Lakers Legend – Kobe Bryant

Today, Jan. 26, is basketball legend Kobe Bryant's third death anniversary. He died at the age of 41 in a helicopter crash in Calabasas, California. Totally nine people died in the accident, and no one was alive. Bryant's 13-year-old daughter, Gianna Bryant, was also killed. Bryant and his daughter were ready for a basketball game on that day. She was going to play in a game and Bryant was her coach.

Bryant played for 20 years with the Los Angeles Lakers and is thought of as one of the best basketball players of all time. He won five NBA championships and two Finals MVPs. He was also an 18-time All-Star. Before his retirement from the NBA, Kobe wrote a poem which was made into a movie that made him win the Best Animated Short Film at the Academy Awards (Oscars) in 2018.
